Presidium's Motion to Amend IDSF Competition Rules

MOVED, that Rule 2 be amended as shown below with underlining and deletions:

Rule 2

Application

- 1. These RULES apply to all international IDSF DanceSport Competitions organized by an IDSF member body granted by IDSF, including but not restricted to Standard, Latin-American, Student-Teacher, New Vogue, American Style, Freestyle, Rock'n Roll, Old Time and Modern and Latin Sequence. Rules for Student-Teacher DanceSport are administered by the IDSF Professional Division. Rules for Rock'n Roll are administered by the IDSF Associate Member the World Rock'n Roll Confederation.
- 2. The IDSF Presidium is responsible for seeing that these RULES are observed.





- 3. For specific events the Presidium may impose supplementary rules on the organizer.
- 4. Every competitor who competes in a competition granted by IDSF must be a member of or registered or affiliated with an national IDSF Member body.

REASONS:

- 1. to make Rule 2(1) clearer, simpler and more accurate so that readers understand which competitions are governed by these Rules; in English the meaning of the expression "international competitions" includes outside competitions one's own country, including competitions in other countries which are governed exclusively by that country's competition rules;
- 2. to include Freestyle in the disciplines governed by the IDSF Competition Rules;
- 3. to include Student-Teacher DanceSport in the disciplines governed by IDSF and administered by the Professional Division; and
- 4. to make Rule 2(4) more accurate because not all athletes are members of their IDSF Member body, but rather are registered or affiliated with that IDSF Member body in some way. We should recognize different methods of organizing DanceSport in various countries and make sure that our Rules govern all athletes regardless of how they are connected to an IDSF Member body.
