Presidium's Motion to Amend IDSF Competition Rules

MOVED, that Rule 5(15) be amended as shown below with underlining and deletions:

<u>Rule 5</u>

15. <u>Choreography and</u> Restrictions of <u>Syllabus</u>

- 1. <u>Subject to these Rules, all choreographies in all ten dances in all IDSF-granted championships, cups and other competitions, are open choreographies.</u>
- 2. In all IDSF granted competitions under RULE governed by this Rule 5 there is a uniform restricted syllabus for all Juveniles age groups. There is only one restriction. The restrictions of This syllabus are worked out is prepared and amended from time to time by a Commission installed by of the IDSF Presidium. This restrictions or changing of the restrictions are syllabus is effective 12 months after publication by circular to all IDSF Member bodies.





- 3. <u>In all competitions</u> the restricted Syllabus <u>must</u> be <u>invigilat</u>ed by a minimum of one qualified Invigilator <u>who</u> shall be <u>appoin</u>ted by the national IDSF <u>Member</u> body <u>governing</u> <u>DanceSport in the country where the competition is produced,</u> <u>but whose appointment must be confirmed by the IDSF</u> <u>Presidium and needs the confirmation of IDSF</u>.
- 4. <u>In all competitions the qualified person Invigilator</u> reports to the chairman. In case of a breach of the restrictions in the first round of a competition, couples shall be warned by the chairman. If there is again a breach of restrictions in the next round or final, the couple shall be disqualified by the chairman.

REASONS:

- 1. to establish a clear Rule 5(15)(1) regarding freedom of choreography in most of our competitions;
- 2. to locate that choreography rule in a logical place in the Rules;
- 3. to eliminate unnecessary repetition and improve the English words, phrases and expressions in the other parts of Rule 5(15).
